Oklahoma's No Child Left Behind Goals (Federal) Approved May 30, 2003

- Goal 1: By 2013-2014, all students will reach high standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics.
- Goal 2: All limited English proficient students will become proficient in English and reach high academic standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics.
- Goal 3: By 2005-2006, all students will be taught by highly qualified teachers.
- Goal 4: All students will be educated in learning environments that are safe, drug-free and conducive to learning.
- Goal 5: All students will graduate from high school.

State Professional Development Goals SB 482 Signed April 24, 2007

- Professional development shall be directed toward development of competencies and instructional strategies in the core curriculum areas for the following goals:
- Goal 1: Increasing the academic performance index (API) scores for the district and each school site.
- Goal 2: Closing achievement gaps among student groups.
- Goal 3: Increasing student achievement as demonstrated on state mandated tests and the ACT test.
- Goal 4: Increasing high school graduation rates.
- Goal 5: Decreasing college remediation rates.
